If you have questions about any of the items listed, please have your student ask his/her teachers during the first days of the school year. Individual teachers will be happy to clarify which supplies are needed for classes, and they do not expect students to have all supplies by the first week. General Supplies - for all classes

Pens – blue, black, and at least one red Large erasers, several Scissors

#2 Pencils and sharpener- mechanical pencils also OK 3" x 5" Index cards

Dry erase markers (low odor) – need lots 30 cm Ruler

3 hole, College-ruled, lined paper
White-out (correction fluid)
Three-hole punch – the kind that fits on rings of a binder
Small stapler

To keep papers and assignments organized, we suggest that students have one morning and one afternoon binder, in different colors, with dividers in each

Supplies Required by Specific Subject or Class

English Copy of Writers INC by Sebranek, Meyer, and Kemper, a collegiate dictionary for home use (e.g., Merriam- Webster Collegiate

or The American Heritage Dictionary), large paper clips (to hold essays, drafts. etc together), one binder w/ at least 4 dividers.

English II: in addition to above, one composition book.

French Colored pencils and 1 ½" binder with 5 dividers and 2 pockets, lined paper, 2 dry erase markers.

German 1/2" 3 ring binder with binder paper, graph paper and a set of index dividers OR section of larger binder; dry erase marker

(replenish all year); colored pen (replenish all year); index cards German II students need a spiral notebook to be used as a

journal

Spanish 3-ring binder with binder paper, subject dividers OR section of larger binder, red pen (replenish all year), dry erase marker

(replenish all year) Spanish-English dictionary: small Langenscheidt recommended, though others OK. Spanish II students

need a journal.

Pre-Algebra and PA Honors

3-ring binder (2 inches), spiral notebook (120 pages maximum), large supply of wooden pencils, OR at least two refillable mechanical pencils with a large supply of extra lead, large eraser, and ruler. Students should bring a dry erase marker with

them to class each day as well. Graph paper will be used 2nd semester. Calculators will be used in PAH after spring break. The

recommended calculator is a TI30xa or the equivalent.

Algebra A One-subject spiral notebook – plastic cover, with pocket for loose papers, preferably from Mead (title "Math", usually yellow

cover, contains about half lined paper and half graph paper), ¼" graph paper, ruler (inches and centimeters), protractor,

compass, scientific calculator - not required until second semester; teacher will explain what is needed.

Algebra B Spiral notebook with plastic cover, ruler (inches & centimeters), protractor, compass, scientific calculator with roots, powers,

sin, cos, tan.

Accel. Algebra One-subject spiral notebook – plastic cover, with pocket for loose papers, preferably from Mead (title "Math", usually yellow

cover, contains about half lined paper and half graph paper), pencils, erasers and ruler. One - 2 inch 3-ring binder. Scientific

(not graphing) calculator (not needed until 2nd semester); teacher will explain what is needed.

Proof Geometry Notebook with pockets (not a binder), a compass that works well, protractor, triangle (no calculator needed), a dry erase

marker to use in class on small boards.

Algebra II/Trig. Same as Proof Geometry supplies plus graph paper, a graphing calculator or access to one. (note: Summit has 6 graphing

calculators for use in the classroom or to loan)

Science 6th - 1 box disposable gloves (Nitrile preferred - many students are allergic to latex) with fingers that fit (size S, mostly),

colored pencils, 1.5"- 3 ring binder with aprox. 50 sheets of graph paper, dry erase markers.

7th and 8th (Chem/Phys and Advanced Topics) - separate 2ⁿ ring binder OR 2" section in AM or PM binder, dedicated-no spirals, calculator w/scientific notation and exponents, 1 box dry erase marker, 1 box overhead marker, blue or black pens,

colored thin line pen (not blue or black) for grading, hole puncher, 1 pad graph paper (7th only)

Social Studies* 6th/7th: 1" 3-ring binder with hard cover, 6 dividers, pencils, blue or black pens, 1 green pen, set of colored pencils, highlighter,

Sharpie and notebook paper, fabric pencil case designed for 3 ring binder, hole reinforcers, 1 spiral notebook, single subject,

70 pages, dry erase markers.

8th. 1/2" binder with 4 dividers (or other organizational system). Required: colored pencils, colored markers (thin lines), dry erase

markers

Art 1 8x10 sketchbook with 40 – 60 unlined pages (not a sketchpad).

PE All PE students must wear a pair of black gym shorts (inseam of at least 3") and a white crew-neck gym t-shirt.
