

The Four Mile Fire Protection District (hereinafter the "District"), Boulder County, Colorado, hereby provides the following information pursuant to the provisions of SB 09-87, a/k/a Section 32-1-809(1)(a)-(i):

a. "The address and telephone number of the principal business office of the special district."

The District, being a volunteer organization with extremely limited financial resources, can not afford to have, and, therefore, does not have a "business office" in the usual sense of the term. Rather, the District uses the principal place of business of its Fire Chief, Bret Gibson, as its "principal business office." That place of business is the Boulder Mountain Lodge, 91 Four Mile Canyon, Boulder, Colorado 80302. The telephone number of the Lodge is 303.444.0882. Anyone calling there should indicate that the call is for the District and should ask to speak to Chief Gibson.

b. "The name and business telephone number of the manager or other primary contact person of the special district."

The District, being a volunteer organization with extremely limited financial resources, can not afford to have, and, therefore, does not have a manager. The closest thing the District has to a "manager" is its Chief, Bret Gibson, whose telephone number is that of his business the Boulder Mountain Lodge, the telephone number of which is 303.444.0882. Anyone calling there desiring to speak to the District's "manager" should indicate that the call is for the District and should ask to speak to Chief Gibson. An "other primary contact person" is the Secretary of the District's board of directors, Robert Beebe, whose telephone number is 303.449.1712.

c. "The names of the members of the board, indicating each member whose office will be on the ballot at the next regular special district election."

The names of the members of the board are as follows. Directors whose offices will be on the ballot at the next regular special district election have an asterisk next to their names

The offices currently held by directors Berbaum and Ray will be voted on for four year terms. The offices held by Directors Benjamin and Wagner will be voted on for two year terms.

d. "The times and places designated for regularly scheduled meetings of the board during the year, and the place where notice of board meetings is posted pursuant to §24-6-402(2)(c) C.R.S."

As has been the case for the past 20+ years, the board holds its regularly scheduled meetings the fourth Wednesday of each month at the District's Salina Station, 546 Gold Run Road, Boulder County, Colorado. That is the only time and the only place designated for regularly scheduled meetings of the board during the year. Notices of board meetings are posted in the window of the District's Salina Station, 546 Gold Run Road, and on the pedestrian doors at the District's Logan Mill Station, 9 Logan Mill Road, and the District's Orodel Station, 87 Four Mile Canyon. A notice is also posted in the County Clerk and Recorder's building, 1750 33rd Street in Boulder. Ask at the office of the Elections Division for the exact location in the building where the notice is posted. The agenda for each meeting of the board is posted on the front pedestrian door of the Salina Station three days prior to each board meeting.

e. "The current mill levy of the special district and the total ad valorem tax revenue received by the district during the last year."

The District's current mill levy is 7.292 mills. The total ad valorem tax revenue received during "the last year" (2008) was \$118,937, which was significantly more than the \$111,476 than the District expected to receive based on the assessed valuation of the taxable property in the District. It could be that some folks had not paid their taxes in previous years and finally got around to paying them in 2008.

f. "The date of the next regular special district election at which members of the board will be elected."

May 4, 2010.

g. "Information on the procedure and time for an eligible elector of the special district to submit a self-nomination form for election to the board pursuant to Section 32-1-804.3."

Self-nomination forms will available from Bret Gibson, acting for Robert Beebe, who is likely to be the Designated Election Official of the District for the election (the Designated Election Official is not actually appointed until the board's regular January election), at the Boulder Mountain Lodge, 91 Four Mile Canyon, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Robert Beebe may be reached by telephone Monday through Friday 8 a.m. through 5 p.m. at 303.449.1712. The forms may be submitted by returning them, properly filled out, to the Boulder Mountain Lodge, Attention: Bret Gibson or Robert Beebe. Self-nomination forms must be filed with the Designated Election Official not less than not less than 67 days prior to the date of the election.

h. The District is required by the provisions of SB 09-87 to state that: "An application to request permanent mail-in voter status can be obtained from the county clerk and recorder, or on-line from the office of the secretary of state, and can be returned to the county clerk and recorder of the county or counties in which the district is wholly or partially located."

Since the District is located wholly in Boulder County, that would mean the Boulder County Clerk and Recorder. Please note that the District has never had a mail-in ballot election.

i. "The address of any web site on which the special district's election results will be posted."
