Skill Sheet: Medical Team Support

Objective

The squad provides medical support at a simulated incident. All members should don latex gloves, be able to provide C-spine support to victims, retrieve medical supplies, assist in packaging, and assist in rolling a victim onto a backboard under medical supervision. Trained team members should play medical roles as they would on a call.

Begin the scenario by arriving at an accident scene. An adult victim is laying on the ground and there	
is possibility of neck/spinal injuries	
The squad will work as a team to "package" the victim onto a backboard.	
The squad leader will announce that the scene has been checked and is safe to approach	
All squad members don latex gloves	
One person will continuously provide C-spine support to victim	
Retrieve a backboard, straps and blocks from vehicle or staging area	
Retrieve a C-collar for victim. Apply the C-collar to victim. Note: Which size collar	
will you use and why?	
Properly roll victim onto backboard. The member providing C-spine support will direct	
the squad movements.	
Strap victim onto backboard	
Apply blocks at the head, and tape down	
Raise victim on the backboard. Each member should lift with the legs and not the back!	
Do not perform this step if there are fewer than 5 people lifting.	
Start Oxygen on patient as directed	
Change tank and regulator. Check for washer.	
Each team member will take turns, selected at random, identifying the following	
items, describing how and when they are used, and where they can be found on	
E1, E3 and B1	
Blankets	
C-Collars	
Oxygen bottle & Re-Breather Mask	
Powered suction machine	
Bag Valve Mask	
Head blocks	
Scoop	
Bean bag	
Stokes Litter
